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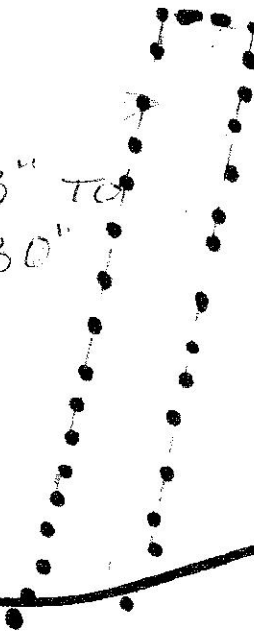
EYE  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $\frac{1}{8}$ " DEEP DO BOTH SIDES



DRILL  $\frac{1}{2}$ " FOR  $\frac{1}{2}$ " DOWELL  
HANDLE

USE  $\frac{1}{2}$ " DOWELL x 6"

DRILL  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3" TO  
HOLD  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30"  
STICK

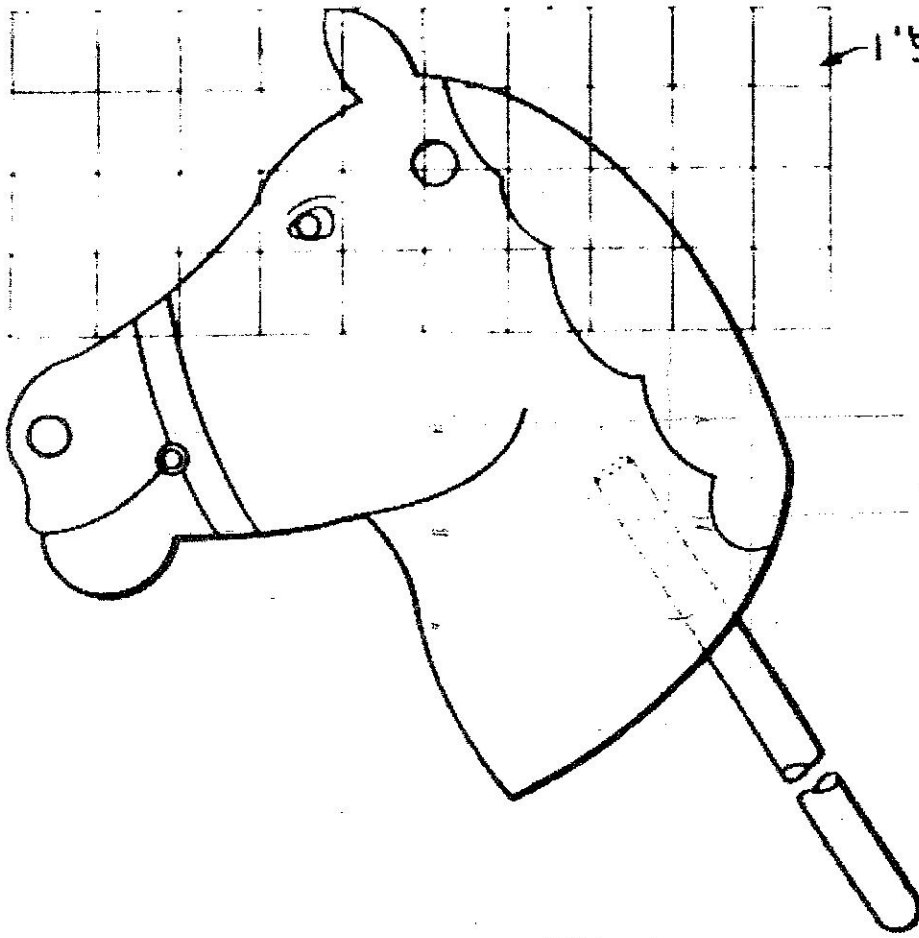

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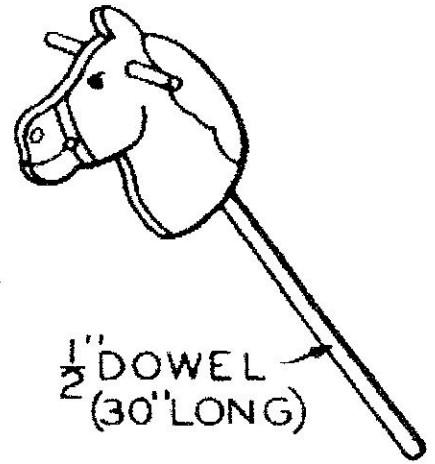

**CONSTRUCTION SEQUENCE for BRONCO RIDING STICK      June 2014**

1. Find and select appropriate wood 3/4" by 10" clear pine
2. Cut to pattern on scroll saw
3. Route all edges with 1/8" round over and sand all surfaces smooth
4. Drill a 1/16" hole (per pattern) to locate eye and handle
5. For eye use 1/2" forester bit and drill 1/8" deep each side of head
6. Use 1/2" drill to make hole to place handle
7. Drill 1/2" x 3" hole as shown on pattern to place riding stick
8. Use a 36" by 1/2" wood dowel cut to a 6" piece for handle using remaining 30" piece for stick
9. Round off end of dowel on handle and stick
10. Use a good wood glue to secure handle and stick, being careful to keep handle free from excess glue
11. Finish as desired
